



United States Department of Labor Employee Benefits Security Administration Abandoned Plan Program Live Webcast

Do you spend a great deal of time dealing with frustrated participants who see their assets eaten away by administrative costs, yet are unable to find a fiduciary to sign off on their distribution? Are you concerned that these abandoned plans are often the subject of enforcement action?

The U.S. Department of Labor, Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) has a program that allows financial institutions holding the assets of abandoned plans to distribute the assets and terminate the plans themselves, or hire others to do so, and use the plan assets to pay reasonable expenses.

EBSAs Los Angeles Regional Office is sponsoring a free webcast to help asset custodians understand how to serve as a Qualified Termination Administrator (QTA). Service providers who may be hired by QTAs under the program will also benefit from this webcast.

During this presentation, you or members of your organization will learn more about the program, and have an opportunity to get answers directly from EBSA representatives on any aspect of the Abandoned Plan Program or the application process.
