A free workshop conducted by EBSA representatives will be offered in your area. The workshop will include an overview of the interaction between the Bankruptcy Code and ERISA.

Protecting Plan Assets in Bankruptcy - We are aware that you may have concerns about your role and responsibilities with respect to employee benefit plans sponsored by employers facing insolvency and bankruptcy. We are inviting you to participate in a seminar addressing how to protect employee benefit plan assets when plan sponsors enter the zone of insolvency and, ultimately, bankruptcy. This half day workshop would be beneficial to Attorneys, Third Party Administrators, C.P.A.s, and Bankruptcy Trustees.

The training will explain interactions between the bankruptcy code and ERISA concerning plan administration and fiduciary responsibility as it relates to bankruptcy. The seminar provides timely and useful information, such as coordinating and interacting with other plan service providers, avoiding prohibited communication with plan participants and beneficiaries, filing required reports, and properly terminating ERISA plans as part of the bankruptcy.
