The Basics – Fiduciary Education, DOL & IRS Correction Programs and the
Affordable Care Act**

A free one day workshop conducted by EBSA regional representatives will be offered in Atlanta, Georgia on Wednesday, August 3, 2011. EBSA will be joined by a representative from the Internal Revenue Service. The workshop is designed to provide "*basic compliance tips and a little more*". Service providers are encouraged to invite client plan fiduciaries and officials to attend this workshop to learn more about their fiduciary duties and compliance responsibilities.

Briefly the workshop will include:

- A session on basic fiduciary responsibilities
- How to self correct violations of ERISA through EBSA's Voluntary Fiduciary Correction Program and IRS Correction Programs
- An overview session on a variety of health law topics including the new Affordable Care Act

Learn how to apply and get approved – You will receive instructions on how to correct ERISA violations and may become eligible for relief from IRS Excise Taxes through participation in the Voluntary Fiduciary Correction Program.
- **IRS Correction Program**
The Employee Plans Compliance Resolution System (EPCRS) provides correction programs to your retirement plans. The components of EPCRS are: Self-Correction Program (SCP), Voluntary Correction Program (VCP), and Audit Closing Agreement Program (Audit CAP).
- **Affordable Care Act**
 - Grandfathered Health Plans
 - Federal External Review Process
 - Coverage of Preventive Services
 - Extension of Coverage for Adult Children
