The Employee Benefits Security Administration and the Kansas Department of Insurance are sponsoring an afternoon workshop on Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangements (MEWA). If you are a licensed broker, agent, ERISA consultant or third-party administrator, this workshop will help you understand federal and state regulations related to this type of group health arrangement as well as help you identify plans that may be fraudulent.
