The Department of Labor, Employee Benefits Security Administration's Los Angeles regional office brings you **Abandoned Plan Program** and **Voluntary Fiduciary Correction Program**, two compliance assistance workshops for Asset Custodians and Plan Service Providers that will provide practical information and help.

Workshop 1: Abandoned Plan Program

This program facilitates the termination of, and distribution of benefits from, individual account pension plans that have been abandoned by their sponsoring employers. This online workshop helps asset custodians understand how to serve as a Qualified Termination Administrator (QTA). Service providers who may be hired by QTAs under the program will also benefit from this workshop.

Workshop 2: Voluntary Fiduciary Correction Program (VFCP)

This program is designed to encourage employers to voluntarily comply with the Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA) by self-correcting certain violations of the law.

During these interactive workshops, you will have an opportunity to ask questions about these programs, as well as obtain one-on-one assistance from EBSA representatives.
