The Employee Plans Compliance Resolution System (EPCRS) provides correction programs to your retirement plans. The components of EPCRS are: Self-Correction Program (SCP), Voluntary Correction Program (VCP), and Audit Closing Agreement Program (Audit CAP).

 - Coverage of Preventive Services
 - Extension of Coverage for Adult Children
