ERISA for Bankruptcy Trustees and Practitioners**

A free workshop conducted by EBSA representatives will be offered in Nashville, Tennessee on June 13, 2012, from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm. The workshop is designed to provide information about ERISA to Bankruptcy Trustees and Practitioners. Registrants are encouraged to invite other staff members and colleagues to attend this workshop to learn more about their fiduciary duties and compliance responsibilities under ERISA.

Briefly the workshop will include:

- **A Primer on ERISA**
We recognize understanding and complying with ERISA can be challenging for any employer, bankruptcy trustee, or service provider. This session provides a general overview of ERISA and includes practical information that will assist fiduciaries, including bankruptcy trustees, and service providers in complying with ERISA.
- **The Role of the Bankruptcy Trustee**
As a result of the passage of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (BAPCPA), the role of the bankruptcy trustee changed dramatically when they are appointed to a debtor who sponsors an employee benefit plan. We will discuss the role of the bankruptcy trustee with respect to employee benefit plans and ERISA.
- **Common Problems Found**
In the five years since the passage of BAPCPA, we have identified common problems created or faced by bankruptcy trustees and practitioners. We will discuss those problems and provide information about how bankruptcy trustees can address the problems in accordance with ERISA.
