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## **DECISION** and **ORDER**

The issues are: (1) whether appellant has any low back conditions or pulmonary embolism causally related to her December 30, 1992 accepted employment injury; and, if so, (2) whether appellant suffered any disability from June 2 through July 25, 1994 causally related to her accepted employment injury.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issues involved, the contentions on appeal, and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated and made final on January 18, 1996 is in accordance with the facts and law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.
