The issue is whether appellant has met her burden of proof in establishing that she sustained an injury in the performance of duty causally related to factors of her employment.

The Board has given careful consideration of the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the May 12, 1998 decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs' hearing representative, is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the hearing representative.

The decisions of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated May 12 1998 and November 19, 1997 are hereby affirmed.¹
