The issue is whether appellant has established that his lower back strain and degenerative disc disease as of October 7, 1992 are causally related to his accepted October 13, 1977 lower back injury.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the June 29, 1998 decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs' hearing representative is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the hearing representative.
