DECISION and ORDER

The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs abused its discretion by terminating appellant's entitlement to monetary compensation benefits under 5 U.S.C. § 8106(c) on the grounds that she refused an offer of suitable work.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the complete case record and appellant's contentions on appeal. The Board finds that the decision of the Office hearing representative dated June 26, 1998 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case, and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the hearing representative.¹

Accordingly, the decisions of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated June 26, 1998 and September 30, 1997 are hereby affirmed.
