The issue is whether appellant sustained more than a nine percent binaural hearing loss, for which he received a schedule award.

The Board finds that the October 15, 1999 decision of the hearing representative of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the hearing representative.
