

examination findings and Dr. Fritzhand's report provided an impairment rating in accordance with the American Medical Association, *Guides to the Evaluation of Permanent Impairment*.

The Board finds that OWCP, in its May 25, 2010 decision, did not review the April 1, 2010 report from Dr. Behrman or the April 4, 2010 report from Dr. Fritzhand that was received by OWCP on April 15 and April 30, 2010. For this reason, the case will be remanded to OWCP to enable it to properly consider all the evidence submitted at the time of the May 25, 2010 decision. Following such further development as OWCP deems necessary, it shall issue an appropriate decision on the merits of the claim.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the May 25, 2010 decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs be set aside. The case is remanded to OWCP for further proceedings consistent with this order of the Board.
