ABOUT THEIR LABOR RIGHTS**

The Department of Labor of the United States of America and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of El Salvador through its Embassy and Consulates in the United States;


**DESIRING** to work collaboratively have declared their intention as follows:

To work together to improve worker awareness of workplace laws and regulations applicable to Salvadoran workers in the United States; to collaborate with each other and other relevant governmental agencies and private organizations as appropriate and as mutually decided upon by our two governments; and to continue to strengthen cooperative relationships between our Governments and promote a better understanding by Salvadoran workers of labor laws and practices in the United States through information sharing, outreach, education, training, and exchange of best practices.

Signed at Washington, D.C., in duplicate in English and Spanish, on the sixth day of November of two thousand fourteen.


