

**JOINT DECLARATION
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF HONDURAS
TO WORK TOGETHER TO INFORM HONDURAN WORKERS
IN THE UNITED STATES
ABOUT THEIR LABOR RIGHTS**

The United States Department of Labor and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Honduras,

DESIRING to work collaboratively, declare their intention as follows:

To work together, through the Embassy and consulates of Honduras in the United States, to foster an environment in which workers' rights are respected, including to improve worker awareness of workplace laws and regulations applicable to Honduran workers in the United States; to collaborate with each other and other relevant governmental agencies and private organizations as appropriate and as mutually decided upon by our two governments; and to continue to strengthen cooperative relationships between our governments and promote a better understanding by Honduran workers and their employers of their labor rights in the United States through information sharing, outreach, education, training, and exchange of best practices.
