SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES	Research Design: Attached a child labor survey as a module to the National Household Survey Sample (PNAD). Socio-demographic and economic characteristics of Brazilians aged ten and above were collected using the PNAD. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Administered a modular household survey to investigate child labor magnitude and practices in Brazil and inform related policy;• Utilized data collected to develop national policy papers and IPEC country program priorities; and• Repeated longitudinal surveys to maintain time series data on child labor practices.
