### U.S. Dept. of Labor's Civil Rights Center to Present Live, **Free** Webinar on the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act -- Effects On the One-Stop System and Job Corps

The U.S. Department of Labor's Civil Rights Center (CRC) will present a live Webinar training session on **March 18, 2009, at 2:00pm EST**, to discuss how the recent changes to Federal disability nondiscrimination law that were made by the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act of 2008 (the ADAAA) will affect the One-Stop system, including the Job Corps program. The Webinar is designed for Equal Opportunity Officers, administrators, and Disability Program Navigators at all levels of the system. Topics will include how the ADAAA has changed the disability nondiscrimination laws that apply to the system, and what steps audience members will need to take as a result of the ADAAA. Scheduled presenters are Denise Sudell, CRC Senior Policy Advisor, and Rashmee Tadvalkar, CRC Equal Opportunity Specialist, both of whom specialize in disability issues. CRC Director Ramón Surís-Fernández will introduce the Webinar; National Association of State Workforce Agencies (NASWA) Economics Director Don Wehbey, who serves as liaison to NASWA's Equal Opportunity Committee, will also provide remarks.
