The Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) and the US Business Leadership Network ® (USBLN) hereby renew the Alliance agreement signed on September 12, 2008 (attached). ODEP and USBLN continue to recognize the value of collaborative efforts to advance the employment opportunities of people with disabilities. ODEP and USBLN remain committed to cooperative and proactive efforts to advance workplace disability practices.
