

RENEWAL ALLIANCE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE OFFICE OF DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT POLICY

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

AND

THE HIGHER EDUCATION RECRUITMENT CONSORTIUM

The Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) and the Higher Education Recruitment Consortium (HERC) hereby renew the Alliance agreement originally signed on April 29, 2013 (attached). ODEP and HERC continue to recognize the value of collaborative efforts to advance employment opportunities of people with disabilities. ODEP and HERC remain committed to cooperative and proactive efforts to advance workplace disability practices within the higher education community. Except as provided in this renewal agreement, all provisions of the April 29, 2013 agreement remain the same.


ODEP's Alliances provide parties an opportunity to participate in a voluntary cooperative relationship with ODEP for purposes such as training and education, outreach and communication and promoting a national dialogue on the recruitment, hiring, advancing and retaining of workers with disabilities. These Alliances have proved to be valuable tools for both ODEP and its Alliance participants. By entering into an Alliance with a party, ODEP is not endorsing any of that party's products or services; nor does the Agency enter into an Alliance with the purpose of promoting a particular party's products or services.

In addition, the implementation team will continue to meet on a regular schedule to track and share information on activities and results in achieving the goals of the Alliance.

This agreement will remain in effect for three years from the date of signing and may be renewed upon the mutual written agreement of the parties. This agreement may be modified at any time with the concurrence of both signatories and may be terminated for any reason with 30 days written notice from either signatory.
