

Statement of Reasons  
For Dismissing a Complaint Concerning the Trusteeship imposed on  
Local 693, Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO,  
On September 18, 2013 in Collins, Mississippi

A member in good standing of the Laborers, Local 693 (Local 693), filed a complaint, on July 3, 2014, with the Secretary of Labor alleging that the trusteeship imposed on Local 693 by Laborers International Union of North America (LIUNA) was not established in accordance with the union's constitution and bylaws and violated Title III of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959, as amended (LMRDA), 29 U.S.C. § 462.

The Department's investigation established that on July 17, 2015, LIUNA reported that Local 693 had neither members nor collective bargaining responsibilities. Accordingly, LIUNA terminated the trusteeship. On October 13, 2015, a Terminal Trusteeship Report Form LM-16 was filed with the Department.


For the reasons set forth above, any questions regarding the use of proper procedures and whether the trusteeship was valid are moot. Accordingly, the Department has concluded that this matter does not require any further action on the part of the Department, and we are closing our file.
