Those who lost the sight of one eye with the sight of the other eye below 0.20.</li><li>2. Those who suffer from motor disturbance in backbone.</li><li>3. Those who are able to engage in light labour only due to conspicuous disorder of the nervous system.</li><li>4. Those who lost fingers of a hand including thumb.</li><li>5. Those who can not use three or more fingers of a hand including thumb and index finger, or thumb or index finger.</li><li>6. Those one leg is shortened 5 centimeters longer.</li><li>7. Those who can not use one joint out to three major joints of an arm.</li><li>8. Those who can not user one joint out of three major joints of a leg.</li><li>9. Those who still have a provisional joint in an arm.</li><li>10. Those who still have a provisional joint in a leg.</li><li>11. Those who lost five toes of one foot.</li><li>12. Those who lost the spleen or one of the kidneys.</li></ol>

Grade 9.  
(350 days' average wage under Article 19 of the  
Labour Standard Law)

1. Those whose sight of both eyes is below 0.6
2. Those whose sight of one eye is below 0.6.
3. Those who suffer from purviblind, narrowness of the field of vision or abnormality in vision.
4. Those who have conspicuous scars of damages inflicted on both eyelids.
5. Those who lack nose or whose nose is damaged and that the function of his nose is disturbed.
6. Those who suffer from disorder of their organ to chew and the speech organ.
7. Those who can not use one ear at all due to lack of or damage to the best part of eardrum.
8. Those who lost thumb of one hand, those who lost two fingers including index finger, or those who lost three fingers other than thumb and index finger.
9. Those who can not use two fingers of a hand including thumb.
10. Those who lost two or more toes of a foot including the first toe.
11. Those who can not use five toes of a foot.
12. Those genital organs are conspicuously disturbed.
