

KOREAN DISABILITY BENEFIT TABLE (CONTINUED)

Grade 10.
(270 days' average wage under Article 19 of the
Labour Standard Law)

1. Those whose sight of one eye is below 0.1.
2. Those who suffer from disorder of the organ to chew or of the speech organ.
3. Those who had dental treatment on 14 or more teeth.
4. Those who can hear loud voice if spoken close to the pinna, because hearing of one ear is weak due to lack of damage to the best part of eardrum.
5. Those who lost index finger of a hand or who lost two fingers other than thumb and index finger.
6. Those who can not use thumb of a hand, those who cannot use two fingers including index fingers other than thumb and index finger.
7. Those whose one leg is shortened 3 centimeters or longer.
8. Those who lost first toe of one leg or lost four other toes.
9. Those who suffer from conspicuous disorder of
10. Those who suffer from conspicuous disorder of the function of one joint of three major joints of a leg.

KOREAN DISABILITY BENEFIT TABLE (CONTINUED)

Grade 11.

(200 day's average wage under Article 19 of the Labour Standard Law)

1. Remarkable functional or material disability left in the eyeballs of both eyes;
2. Remarkable material disability left in the eyelids of both eyes;
3. Remarkable defects left in the eyelid of one eye;
4. Deafness of one ear, having only perception of normal voice within 40 centimeters as the result of moderate damages of tympana or other disabilities;
5. The deformity left in the spiral column;
6. The loss of the third or fourth finger of one hand;
7. The loss of use of the second finger or two fingers other than the thumb and second finger of one hand;
8. The loss of use of more than two toes of one foot including the first toe; or
9. Disability left in the thoracic and abdominal organs.
