Subject: SSFL - Job Descriptions

Hi, Guys ~

I hope this e-mail finds you well and having a great week.

Several weeks ago, I submitted a few Job Descriptions for review by the SEM Public Admin. I was remiss in neglecting to reference corresponding Case ID Numbers, so the documents could be easily verified. Some clearly lack the obvious company logo or other identifying information. I was asked to resubmit, with the corresponding Case ID.

I decided I might as well be thorough. Attached, please find a PDF that contains all of the Job Descriptions I currently have for Santa Susana (SSFL), Canoga, VanOwen, DeSoto and Downey Facility. These were obtained under the Privacy Act, and exist in the DAR / Case File. In your review, you may notice that Boeing's EE-5 EV sometimes notes that the Job Descriptions are "all they could find," as they may be outdated, or may not exactly match a worker's official job title. Certainly, as you review actual DAR records, you will see that official Job Titles / Job Descriptions vary greatly from tasks that were routinely performed.

I included Case ID Numbers, and Work Locations to help SEM cross-reference between Job Titles / Processes / Locations / Hazardous Substance Lists. Also, in reviewing Boeing's EE-5 EV "Time Clock Location Summary," I noted possible correlations between specific non-Area IV "Time Clock Locations" and verified Area IV Job Titles / Labor Categories. Given our continued dialogue on this topic, I included "Time Clock Locations" associated with the Job Descriptions, too.

No PII is included in the document.

If you think the information is useful and the format is acceptable, please let me know - I'm happy to build on this, as I run into more Job Descriptions.

If it needs to be adjusted, or additional information would be helpful, let me know that, too.

It's a privilege to submit information for your review, on behalf of SSFL and its associated sites.
