Maintenance mechanic – sheet metal

John Smith has about 15 ½ years of total covered employment, of that, he spent about 14 ½ years at the Kansas City Plant and the remainder at Pantex. At the Kansas City Plant, he worked as a sheet metal worker for approximately 10 years (11/24/1980 – 1/7/1991). The primary job process he was involved in as a sheet metal work at the Kansas City Plant was fabrication. In addition to his work as a sheet metal worker at Kansas City, Mr. Smith also worked as a spray painter for a year, (5/21/92 – 10/14/96) and as a production fabricator for one year (10/14/1996 -10/1/97). Thereafter, Mr. Smith worked at Pantex for about a year (10/14/1996 through 10/1/97) as a maintenance mechanic (sheet metal).
