

Notice of Election Under Section 204 of WRERA

Each year under the Pension Protection Act (PPA) of 2008 the plan sponsor is required to have the status of pension plan certified as either safe, endangered, or critical. Plans in endangered or critical status are required to implement changes to benefits and/or contributions with the goal of improving the plan's funded status. Under Section 204 of the Worker, Retiree, and Employer Recovery Act (WRERA) of 2008, the plan sponsor is allowed to temporarily elect to freeze the plan's status so that is the same as the plan's status for the plan year immediately prior to the election year. This temporary election was designed to allow time for markets to recover and hopefully improve the plans status in future years.

This election applies only to the election year. If the plan is certified to be in endangered or critical status in the year following the election year, the plan sponsor will provide notice of the plan's status for that year and steps will be taken to improve the plan's funded situation. These steps may include increases in contributions and/or reductions in future benefit accruals.

For plans certified to be in critical status, the steps taken to improve the plans funded status will include a surcharge on employer contributions and the suspension of the payment of lump sums and similar accelerated distributions. These accelerated distributions may include amendments to reduce early retirement benefits or other adjustable benefits for individual plan participants.
