TO: All Participants, Beneficiaries, Participating Unions and Contributing Employers

The Board of Trustees have made an election under Section 204 of the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 to treat the I.A.T.S.E. Local No. 16 Pension Plan as being neither in endangered nor critical status for the Plan Year beginning January 1, 2009. The Plan would have been in critical status had this election not been made as was certified to the Secretary of the Treasury by the Plan's actuary. This election applies only for the January 1, 2009 Plan Year. If the Plan is certified to be in endangered or critical status for the January 1, 2010 Plan Year, notice will be provided as to the Plan's status and steps will be taken to improve the Plan's funded situation.

If the Plan is certified to be in critical status for the January 1, 2010 Plan Year, the steps that will have to be taken to improve the Plan's funded situation will include a surcharge on employer contributions and may include amendments to reduce early retirement subsidies or other adjustable benefits for such individuals.
