Dear Kathleen Sebelius, Secretary of Health & Human Services,

I commend the Department of Health & Human Services' landmark decision requiring health insurers to cover the full cost of contraception, with no co-pay, beginning in August 2012.

As a supporter of Planned Parenthood, I know the tremendous financial burden birth control pills put on middle class and poor families who want to space their children as well as single women. This helps.

This policy places a much-needed importance on women's health that is too-often not a priority in health care policy.
