

LICENSE AND RELEASE

The Video is an original work and does not constitute an infringement of any valid copyright, and DOL’s exercise of the License Rights will not infringe upon or violate any rights of any third party, including the individuals that appear in the Video.
6. You have obtained a valid written consent from any and all individuals whose image, likeness, and/or voice are contained in the Video. You will provide DOL such consent/s upon request.
7. You release and agree to hold harmless and indemnify DOL and its officers, employees, and agents against liability, including costs, for actual or alleged direct or indirect infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any copyright or trademark arising out of DOL’s use of the Video, and any actual or alleged violation of an individual’s privacy and/or publicity rights, provided you or your organization is reasonably notified of such claims and/or proceedings.
8. This License and Release comprises the entire agreement and understanding with regard to the subject matter of this license and supersedes any prior agreements and understandings between and among them respecting the subject matter hereof.
9. No change, modification, amendment, termination or waiver of this License and Release shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of each party.
