Employer has timely moved for reconsideration of the Board's Order on Motion to Dismiss in which the Board dismissed the appeals in *Bajrami v. BL Harbert Int'l, L.L.C.*, BRB Nos. 19-0395/A, 19-0397/A (Nov. 25, 2019) as interlocutory. 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §802.407. The Director, Office of Workers' Compensation Programs responds, urging rejection of employer's motion. Claimants have not responded. As a majority of the panel has not voted to grant reconsideration, employer's motion is denied. 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §§801.301(b); 20 C.F.R. §802.409.
