JUDGE SENTENCES COMPANY OWNER TO PROBATION

FOR EMBEZZLING FROM PROFIT SHARING PLAN

United States Attorney Mary Beth Buchanan announced today, May 2, 2008, that William R. McAnulty, a resident of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, has been sentenced in federal court in Pittsburgh to a term of 2 years probation on his conviction of Theft from an Employee Benefit Plan.

United States District Judge Nora Barry Fischer imposed the sentence on McAnulty, age 68 of 301 Canterbury Drive, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

According to information presented to the court by Assistant United States Attorney Kay B. Lee, McAnulty stole and converted to his own use and the use of another individual approximately \$29,660.00 from the E.R. Caldwell Land Clearing Contractors, Inc.'s employee profit sharing plan.

"The Department of Labor will not tolerate the theft of the retirement benefits of workers and their families," said

Bradford P. Campbell, Assistant Secretary of the Employee Benefits Security Administration. "Today's court action demonstrates the government's commitment to justice by recovering workers' money and seeking punishment for violators."

Ms. Buchanan commended Stephanie Thimodo of the Department of Labor for the investigation leading to the successful prosecution of William R. McAnulty.
