The actuary for the Asbestos Workers Local 91 Pension Plan, O'Sullivan Associates, has certified the Plan is not projected to have a funding deficiency within the next seven years. The Pension Fund's assets are less than 80% of its projected liabilities. Therefore, the Pension Fund is still in Endangered Status (Yellow Zone). Endangered Status is described in Section 432 of the Internal Revenue Code.

As required by law, this serves as Notice to you that the Pension Fund is in Endangered Status as of January 1, 2010.

In compliance with law, the Plan Trustees have developed a Funding Improvement Plan that is to raise the funding level of the Plan. The Funding Improvement Plan requires increased contributions from employers as shown below:
