Notice of Endangered Status For

Bakery Drivers and Salesmen Local 194 and Industry Pension Fund

This is to inform you that on January 29, 2010 the plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the plan sponsor, that the Bakery Drivers and Salesmen Local 194 and Industry Pension Fund (the "Plan") is in endangered status for the plan year beginning November 1, 2009.

Endangered Status

The plan is considered to be in endangered status because it meets the standards of that status as set out by the 2006 Pension Protection Act ("PPA"). More specifically, the plan's actuary determined that the plan's funded percentage for the 2008 plan year is between 65% and 80%, but over the next seven plan years, the plan is not projected to have an accumulated funding deficiency.

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in endangered or seriously endangered status to adopt a funding improvement plan aimed at restoring the financial health of the plan. This funding improvement plan must be submitted to the appropriate parties by September 26, 2010. As reported last year, the Plan was in endangered status last year as well. A funding improvement plan was submitted to the appropriate parties and is being followed. Therefore the Trustees of the Plan are required to continue following the funding improvement plan in process, however the Trustees are monitoring the Plan to make sure the current plan is sufficient. We shall continue to do so following the guidance under PPA.
