The actuary for the Local No. 697 IBEW and Electrical Industry Pension Fund, Chicago Benefit Consultants, Inc., has certified that the Pension Fund is in Endangered Status (Yellow Zone). Endangered Status is described in Section 432(b)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Pension Fund's assets are less than 80% of its projected liabilities. The Pension Fund is not expected to have a deficiency in its Funding Standard Account in the next seven years.

As required by law, this serves as Notice to you that the Pension Fund is in Endangered Status as of January 1, 2009.

In further compliance with the law, the Plan Trustees are developing a Funding Improvement Plan that is to raise the funding level of the Plan to at least that required by the Pension Protection Act.
