Notice of Endangered Status For
Plumbers and Pipefitters Local 152 Pension Fund

This is to inform you that on July 7, 2010 the Plan actuary certified to the U. S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the Plan sponsor, that the Plan is in endangered status for the plan year beginning May 1, 2010. Federal law requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered Status

The Plan is considered to be in endangered status because it has a funding problem. More specifically, the Plan's actuary determined that the Plan's funded percentage as of May 1, 2010 is less than 80%.

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in endangered status to adopt a funding improvement plan aimed at improving the financial health of the Plan over ten years. Since the Plan was endangered in 2008, a funding improvement plan was adopted July 30, 2008. As part of the Funding Improvement Plan, the Plan applied for and received approval for a 5-year automatic extension of the charge bases as detailed in the April 17, 2009 notice. In addition, the funding improvement period has been extended from ten years to thirteen years in accordance with the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008.
