

**Notice of Endangered Status
for the
Laborers' District Council of Western Pennsylvania Pension Plan

This is to inform you that in accordance with applicable Federal law, on March 28, 2022 the Pension Fund Benefit Plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also to the Plan sponsor, that the Plan is in endangered status for the plan year beginning January 1, 2022. Federal law also requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered Status

A plan is considered to be in endangered status because it has funding problems. More specifically, the Pension Plan's actuary determined that the Plan's funded percentage for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022 is less than 80% (a comparison of the assets to the present value of accumulated benefits).

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in endangered status to adopt a funding improvement plan within 240 days of the certification date. A funding improvement plan is aimed at restoring the financial health of the plan. The law permits pension plans to reduce certain future benefits as part of a funding improvement plan as well as increase contributions. The Board adopted a funding improvement plan, with no changes to benefits or contributions as structured under the Rehabilitation Plan, on January 31, 2018.
