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## General Comment

In the individual market, if a member was enrolled on March 23, 2010, he is grandfathered along with all dependents on the individual policy. What if a newborn is added, is that child grandfathered? What if the member wants to add a dependent who was previously not enrolled (because they may have been on another policy) or not eligible (a person over 18 who did not meet eligibility criteria before the Age 26 change in PPACA). Are these members allowed to join the plan and are they grandfathered?
