I urge you in the strongest terms possible to rescind the intrusive, coercive mandate that all "contraceptives" and sterilization procedures be covered by private health insurance with no patient copay. This mandate clearly violates the spirit of conscience laws that prohibit government discrimination against any who object to health services on moral or religious grounds.
