General Comment

RE: CMS-9992-IFC2 I fully support that all women should have access to contraception care as presented in the new health regulations. I am very concerned with the religious right's efforts to expand the "religious employer" exemption. This is just another way for this group to systematically chip away at individual freedom and rights and the separation of church and state.

The matter of whether or not to utilize family planning options is a private decision for each ndividual alone. When choosing to serve the public in a health occupation, a provider's personal belief should be separate from his/her public role.
