

The Board, having considered the fee petition and supporting documentation, denies the fee petition. Enclosed with the fee petition was an itemized statement of services and corresponding fees. The itemized statement, however, includes services dating back to November 2019, which predates the April 3, 2020 appeal in Docket No. 20-0978. The fee petition fails to distinguish the services performed in connection with the present appeal before the Board from the services performed before OWCP. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the fee petition in the amount of \$1,837.50 is denied and may be resubmitted to the Board within 60 days of the date of this order.
