The Board notes that all petitions for approval of fees for representatives' services are considered under the Board's statutory authority found at section 8127 of the Federal Employees' Compensation Act,¹ (FECA) and under its *Rules of Procedure* found at 20 C.F.R. § 501.9(e).

The fee petition specified services provided with regard to Docket No. 19-1532 from June 27 through July 15, 2019, in the amount of \$783.75; and services provided with regard to Docket No. 21-0723 from April 14 through 20, 2021 in the amount of \$795.00.

As required by the Board's regulations, appellant has been afforded written notice of the fee requested and provided an opportunity to comment on the fee petition.² Attached to the fee petition is a signed acknowledgement by appellant consenting to the fee in the amount of \$1,578.75.
