

Project Summary (Need)

The proposed Employment Recovery DWG would provide employment and training services to eligible individuals displaced as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Employment Recovery Activities

The assistance the state proposes include assistance with basic career services, individualized career services, support services, training services, and follow-up services.

Eligible Participants

Workers laid off due to quarantine orders or business closures related to disruptions caused by the outbreak are eligible participants. Also eligible are workers unable to go to their regular workplace due to social distancing requirements, as well as those missing work to care for a family member.
