

## Supporting Wisconsin's COVID-19

### Dislocated Workers

Statewide

## Project Summary (Need)

Wisconsin seeks flexibility to either serve the entire state (all 72 counties) or focus grant activities in those counties most impacted by the COVID-19 public health emergency and corresponding economic crisis. Wisconsin's service strategy for geographic areas served under this grant will, be driven by (1) the status of the public health emergency and economic crisis at time of award, and (2) amount of funds awarded.

## Disaster Relief Employment

Wisconsin's COVID-19 Disaster Recovery DWG will create disaster-relief jobs focused on the provision of humanitarian assistance and supportive services. Positions to expand the capacity of non-profit, charitable organizations that provide humanitarian assistance to community members.

## Eligible Participants

Workers laid off due to quarantine orders or business closures related to disruptions caused by the outbreak are eligible participants. Also eligible are workers unable to go to their regular workplace due to social distancing requirements, as well as those missing work to care for a family member.
