

Dislocated Workers

Project Summary (Need)

Nevada is requesting this funding to support disaster relief employment and to support employment and training activities for dislocated workers, focusing on in-demand sectors and occupations that were directly impacted by the COVID-19 disaster. This funding will address unprecedented needs and provide the State of Nevada's dislocated workers with access to critical services, helping them return to work.

Disaster Relief Employment

The state proposes to provide essential employment and training activities as well as disaster relief employment opportunities. Positions to support social service agencies providing basic needs; temporary staffing at government agencies providing critical resources; and manufacturing positions addressing the needed resources during the COVID-19 public health emergency. Proposed Employment and Training Activities: Occupational training focused on the in-demand fields of healthcare and distribution/warehousing.

Eligible Participants

Workers laid off due to quarantine orders or business closures related to disruptions caused by the outbreak are eligible participants. Also eligible are workers unable to go to their regular workplace due to social distancing requirements, as well as those missing work to care for a family member.
