Project Summary (Need)

This funding request will address the exceptional need in Nevada and provide dislocated workers with access to critical services and help them return to work. The COVID-

19 crisis has caused rapid devastation to Nevada's economy. With this funding, Nevada jobseekers will be provided with training opportunities to support the employment needs of local businesses.

Employment Recovery Activities

The employment recovery funding will support a variety of occupational skills training activities for dislocated workers for in-demand occupations that have been directly impacted due to COVID-19. Nevada will provide full-service reemployment services and resources that include access to Nevada's MIS, EmployNV, that allows individuals to: search for jobs; connect to Nevada's JobConnect Offices and American Job Centers for reemployment assessment services; access job development, training and placement resources; find labor market information; receive resume and cover letter assistance; attend employment-related workshops; receive referrals to WIOA mandated partners; and obtain information on Nevada's unemployment insurance benefits. This funding will also be utilized to provide occupational skills training and OJT to upskill dislocated workers with in-demand

Eligible Participants

Workers laid off due to quarantine orders or business closures related to disruptions caused by the outbreak are eligible participants. Also eligible are workers unable to go to their regular workplace due to social distancing requirements, as well as those missing work to care for a family member.
