<b>Project Description</b>	This supplemental funding will provide these dislocated workers, all of whom are certified eligible for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA), with continued access to “wrap-around” and supportive services that are not covered under the TAA program.

<b>Training/Services</b>	This supplemental funding will assist the 56 remaining participants, 41 of whom require help with job search, case management services, and transition support. The other 15 individuals require funding support to continue their current training programs in 2016.
