<b>Target Group</b>	Individuals who have evacuated from Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands to Massachusetts, as a result of the damage and destruction caused by Hurricanes Irma and Maria.
<b>Project Description</b>	This project will provide reemployment services to eligible individuals who evacuated from Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands as a result of the extensive damage caused by Hurricanes Irma and Maria. These hurricanes were declared major disasters in September 2017 by the Federal Emergency Management Agency under the following declarations: <i>Puerto Rico Hurricane Irma</i> (DR-4336), <i>Puerto Rico Hurricane Maria</i> (DR-4339), <i>U.S. Virgin Islands Hurricane Irma</i> (DR-4335), and <i>U.S. Virgin Islands Hurricane Maria</i> (DR-4340).
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
