<b>Project Description</b>	This incremental funding of \$351,708 will continue the delivery of employment and training assistance to those participants already enrolled in the project, as well as provide services to new participants

<b>Training/Services</b>	Examples of the services provided include assessment testing, career counseling, job search support and guidance, remedial and occupational training for English Language Learning, and classroom training.
