The state also plans to develop a mobile application linking people to workforce and support resources. The second strategy will be to increase the number of Certified Recovery Specialists. The third will be to educate and engage employers that support individuals in recovery. These efforts are based on the Recovery Friendly Workplace program being implemented in New Hampshire, in which participating employers are willing to hire and work with people in recovery. |
