Qualifying Events

Between July 2021 and October 2021, multiple wildfires in six northern California counties burned more than 1.4 million acres, a land area larger than the state of Delaware. The wildfires destroyed thousands of structures and burned huge sections of Lassen National Forest, Lassen National Park, Plumas National Forest, and Trinity National Forest. The disaster devastated the lumber industry across northern California, exacerbating ongoing national lumber shortages and making it harder to rebuild following the disaster events.



California's request for funding will help to create disasterrelief employment, including debris and damage cleanup resulting from the wildfires, as well as provide for employment and training services for eligible individuals in the affected areas.
