The project plans to provide participants with career and training services that include on-the-job-training, work experience, and occupational skills training; purchase technology solutions to conduct virtual Job Fairs, mobile services, and online learning; and expand outreach and strategic partnerships.



### Project Goals

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted UI or other COVID-19-related UI programs.
